PV 5th Grade Field Trip to Andes Towers Hills

Dear Parents,

The physical education teachers invite your 5th grader to come downhill skiing with us Thursday, February 2nd, 2017 at Andes Tower in Alexandria, MN. We will be leaving school promptly at 7:40am, just after the last bus arrives. We will be gone the whole school day and will be returning by 2:00pm. All students who are at school on February 2nd will be going with, if they are not skiing they will be in the chalet.



The students have been cross country skiing in physical education class for the last 2 years. We have practiced stopping on our ski's, staying balanced, moving on flat surfaces and going down our mini hill. The students will receive a mini lesson (if needed), ski rental equipment, lift ticket and transportation for \$10.00. Students can elect to receive a school sack lunch, bring their own sack lunch from home or buy snacks at the snack bar.

Parents are welcome as chaperones. We are looking for 2 per classroom. Please contact your child's classroom teacher if you are interested in helping. Background checks are needed for all chaperones. There will be a \$10.00 lift ticket/ski rental fee if you would like to ski.

The deadline to return the permission slip and payment of \$10.00 is Wednesday January 25th

WHAT TO WEAR SKIING:

Each child should remember that staying warm is the most important part of enjoying the outdoors. Looks are not important.

ON YOUR LEGS:

- 1. Long underwear or warm PJ pants if possible
- 2. Snow pants are necessary or athletic pants layered
- 3. Jeans with layers underneath are good
- 4. Layer socks and bring extras

ON ARMS AND CHEST:

- Sweatshirt
- 2. Winter Jacket

ON HANDS AND HEAD:

- 1. Winter gloves that are insulated (bring extra's)
- 2. Stocking cap and headband (ears must be covered)
- 3. No long scarves as they could get caught on the chair lift

**It is better to have lots of layers on, and then shed them as your child gets warm, rather than be too cold.
